Mr. Chairman Nelson and Members of the Committee,

My name is Shiloh Eagle. I am an enrolled member of Standing Rock Sioux Tribe. I am a single father raising two children in Bismarck ND.

I am here today in **support** of Senate Bill 2012.

I have been a client of NATIVE, Inc.'s Community Connect program since July 2022. I have been receiving peer support services since enrolling into this program.

The community connect program has helped me obtain stability. This program helped me get my own apartment for me and my children. It has also helped to find resources that apply to helping me in my situation. Most importantly, it has helped me stabilize my housing. This program also helped me get gas, food, and household cleaning supplies until I was able to get my next paycheck. But it has also helped me to learn how to budget my monthly income.

I needed help because I became a single parent with one income. So, me and my children had to stay with friends and even at a hotel. I learned about NATIVE, Inc. and they helped me get housing and services. In my situation I have a genetic disability diagnosis that put me on social security benefits. The community connect program helped me find the landlord that was willing to rent to me. My care coordinator was critical to making this happen because she facilitated the needed paperwork and needed program requirements that paid for first month's rent and security deposit. Peer support services has helped me become comfortable with who I am now. I am a single father of two kids. Becoming a better parent has always been what I wanted to do but I've always been hesitant to ask for help but the help that I get at NATIVE, Inc. is not forced and is more natural, more like a friendship. they helped me work with mental health, helped me with the small victories everyday not just the big one that everyone sees or knows.

NATIVE, Inc. is helping me break the generational traumas. I grew up with my dad who spent our money and moved us around place to place. But with NATIVE, Inc.'s help I know that I can make our place a home to me and my kids. A place to feel safe and stable.

NATIVE, Inc. is important to the community because it's building a Native community. It helps us create new friendships amongst other Native people who might not otherwise ever met, leaving us isolated and alone.
