Admin - 5 positions were for zones transfers they were moved back into zones

Medical - Removed the 1 position for early intervention team

Aging - 67 aging positions were for zones transfers that were moved back into zones, removed 10 HCBS case managers and reduced to 7 which were moved into zones, 4 the first year of biennium, 3 the second

CFS - Removed the 4 child protection and response team, wanted Dept to reclassify 4 other positions in budget for these positions.

DD - Removed 2 DDPM positions

Early Childhood - Removed 1 for best in class

HSC's - added 24 positions for CCBHC's
