2 Mandan Public Schools – Mike Bitz, Superintendent

Good afternoon Chairman Heinert and members of the House
Education Committee. For the record, my name is Mike Bitz. I
am fortunate to serve as the superintendent for Mandan Public
Schools. I am here today in support of HB1464. I will be brief.

Currently the state of ND has an "insurance policy" in law for ND 7 school districts. Local school districts are responsible for all costs 8 associated with educating a student up to 4X the state average cost 9 of education per pupil, (in 2021-2022 this amount was roughly 10 \$56,000). Once a district reaches the threshold of 4X the average 11 cost of education the state will reimburse districts for excess costs 12 beyond that amount for all "special education" students. I believe 13 that when this legislation was adopted the thought was that it 14 would not be possible to have a high-cost student that was not a 15 special education student. 16

It is very rare for a non-special education student to reach the high-cost threshold, in fact, to the best of my knowledge, there currently is only 1 high-cost student in the state that is not a special education student. This student is medically fragile and
requires a full-time nurse to participate in school. This student is
extremely intelligent and one of the top students in the school,
while the student has intense medical needs, the student does not
qualify for special education services.

This legislation will afford school districts protection for all highcost students whether they qualify for special education services
or they qualify because of medical condition.
