My name is Rebekah Oliver and I write as a private resident of North Dakota. Please recommend a Do Pass on House Bill 1489.

The distinct differences between males and females were the original incentive to create female sports, allowing women to compete safely, and to have equal opportunity to earn athletic recognition, awards, and scholarships.
