## Opposition to HB 1522

I am writing to express my alarm and great opposition to HB 1522. I urge a Do Not Pass.

This bill discriminates against the transgender community, and for what purpose? Transgender youths are already at higher risk for depression and suicide. This bill seeks to ostracize them even more. For a Legislature that prides itself on freedoms and on being pro-life, this bill is clearly big government meddling in the affairs of local schools and other people's private lives. It takes away freedoms from transgender youth, takes away the ability of schools and teachers to make healthy accommodations for these students, takes away the ability of school counselors to provide good mental health care for transgender students.
