

**Testimony**  
**Engrossed Senate Bill No. 2026**  
**House Human Services Committee**  
**Representative Robin Weisz, Chairman**

Chairman Weisz, and members of the House Human Services Committee, I am Jonathan Alm, an attorney with the Department of Health and Human Services (Department). I appear before you in support of Engrossed Senate Bill No. 2026.

The Department's 2021-23 budget allowed for the Department to demolish the chapel, administrative building, employee building, and associated tunnels at the State Hospital only if the Department was able to find general fund savings to use on the demolition projects. The Department obtained an estimate from an architect firm of \$3,272,902 on February 11, 2022, to demolish the three buildings and tunnels, two of the five buildings which are listed in this Bill. The Department did not receive any appropriation from the 67<sup>th</sup> Legislative Assembly for the demolition projects. The Department does not have funding for the demolition projects and would need an appropriation to demolish the administrative building, employee building, associated tunnels, milk barn, pig barn, and water treatment plant buildings in the next biennium.
