1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying the feasibility
2	and desirability of renovating and constructing an addition to the Liberty Memorial Building or
3	constructing a new building on the grounds of the state Capitol to serve as a new Supreme
4	Court building.
5	WHEREAS, the idea of housing the Supreme Court in a stand-alone building is not a new
6	concept; and
7	WHEREAS, since at least 1924, the plans for the Capitol grounds included a separate
8	"Temple of Justice" that would mirror the architectural design of the Liberty Memorial Building;
9	and
0	WHEREAS, as a result of the Supreme Court's expanding space needs, in 2015, then-
11	Governor Jack Dalrymple proposed appropriating \$40 million to repurpose the Liberty Memorial
2	Building into a Supreme Court building; and
3	WHEREAS, the 2015 proposal did not advance due to the rapid downturn in the economy
4	which occurred at that time; and
15	WHEREAS, locating the Supreme Court in the Liberty Memorial Building would be a
16	homecoming for the Court;
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
8	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
9	That the Legislative Management consider studying the feasibility and desirability of
20	renovating and constructing an addition to the Liberty Memorial Building or constructing a new
21	building on the grounds of the state Capitol to serve as a new Supreme Court building; and
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the study include input from the Supreme Court and the
23	Office of Management and Budget; and
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the study consider the feasibility and desirability of
25	relocating the State Library or constructing a new building on the grounds of the State Capitol
