OTHER FUNDS

The purpose of this capital request is to address Title IX compliance, health and safety concerns for the environmental air exchange system, accreditation, compliance, and regulatory size of the athletic/intermural space as well as ADA access for BSC students', staff, and community. This Multi-purpose capital project which addresses the operational compliance issues outlined above would be a new 80,000 sq. foot academic/intermural/athletic facility to advance BSC's polytechnic programming and applied research mission while at the same time addressing current Title IX compliance factors and environmental operational life/health/safety issues. The estimated cost of this facility is approximately \$31,500,000 and includes resolution of the current operational Title IX compliance, health and safety environmental issue, academic programming and instructional delivery space, and competition infrastructure for a regulation complainant multi-purpose athletic space.
