1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the impact artificial  
2 intelligence has on the state.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE**  
5 **IMPACTS.** During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the  
6 rapid emergence of artificial intelligence and the potential impacts on the state's institutions,  
7 agencies, businesses, citizens, and youth. The study must include a review of the effect of  
8 artificial intelligence on the provision of health care, effects on student learning, potential  
9 opportunities or threats to the integrity of state services, the potential impact of deep fakes on  
10 electoral processes including mitigating action to be taken leading up to the 2024 state  
11 elections, opportunities for state investment or policy changes to promote artificial intelligence  
12 businesses, and cybersecurity implications across all state institutions. The legislative  
13 management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation  
14 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
