Most beekeepers try to keep the bees away from roads. But to require the bees be placed  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a mile from a road is not possible in many places. It also is not going to affect anything. Just because the bees are farther from the road is not going to make them fly over the road. IF the floral source is on the other side of the road that is where the bees will go. They could be a mile away and they would still go across the road. They only fly as high as they have to.
