- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to growth and development and human sexuality curriculum.

#### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Growth and development and human sexuality curriculum - Content.

- 1. As used in this section:
  - a. "Human growth and development discussion" means an oral, written, or digital lesson, lecture, or presentation about human biology related to pregnancy and human development inside the womb.
    - <u>b.</u> "Human sexuality instruction" means an oral, written, or digital lesson, lecture, or presentation about sexual activity and pregnancy in the context of student health or healthy relationships.
- 14 <u>2. A school district's life science health curriculum must include human growth and development</u>
- discussion. The human growth and development discussion must include:
  - <u>A high-definition ultrasound video, at least three minutes in duration, showing the development of the brain, heart, sex organs, and other vital organs in early fetal development; and</u>
  - b. A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation showing the process of fertilization and every stage of human development inside the uterus, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ development for every week of pregnancy until birth.
  - 3. A school district offering human sexuality instruction shall ensure human sexuality instruction includes:

- a. A high-definition ultrasound video, at least three minutes in duration, showing the development of the brain, heart, sex organs, and other vital organs in early fetal development; and
  b. A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation showing the process of fertilization and every stage of human development inside the uterus, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ development for every week of pregnancy until birth.
  - 4. The superintendent of public instruction shall ensure the requirements of this section are included in the North Dakota science healthcontent standards.
