Amendment. Section 23-17.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

23-17.3-01. Definitions.

- 1. "Home health services" means a broad range of health and social services furnished to individuals and families by a home health agency or by others under arrangements with the agency, in the places where the recipients are presently residing. Services must include the services of a currently licensed registered professional nurse and at least on other therapeutic services and may include additional support services. These services may only be provided with the approval of a licensed physician or an allowed practitioner.
- 2. <u>"Allowed Practitioner" means a physician assistant (PA), nurse practitioner (NP), or clinical nurse specialist (CNS).</u>

23-17.3-05 Standards of licensure.

- 1. The agency shall have a supervising physician or a supervising registered professional nursean allowed practitioner who is responsible for the direction, coordination, and general supervision of the therapeutic services provided by the agency and who is employed on a full-time basis. There must be supervision from a physician or registered professional nurseallowed practitioner during all hours of operation.
- 2. The agency shall maintain clinical records on all patients to serve as documentation of the medical, nursing, and therapeutic care rendered to the patient and for communication between the physician <u>or allowed practitioner</u> and the agency.
