

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO FIRST ENGROSSMENT
ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1368

Page 1, remove lines 18-24, and replace with:

“3. The state shall determine whether a company boycotts Israel in response to the receipt of evidence of such activity. A company statement that it is participating in boycotts of Israel or that it has taken the boycott action at the request, in compliance with, or in furtherance of calls for a boycott of Israel, can be considered as one type of evidence that a company is participating in a boycott of Israel when accompanied with the conduct described under subsection 1. Expressive activity alone, directed at a specific person or a government action, may not be considered evidence of a boycott of Israel.”

Page 2, Line 16, remove: “which has more than ten full-time employees”

Page 2, Line 19, replace: “Failure to comply with this subsection does not affect the enforceability of a contract.” With: “The office of management and budget or purchasing agency may waive this requirement when determined to be in the best interest of the state, and such waiver shall not affect the enforceability of the contract.”

Page 2, after line 20 insert:

“3. The state shall determine whether a company boycotts Israel in response to the receipt of evidence of such activity. A company statement that it is participating in boycotts of Israel or that it has taken the boycott action at the request, in compliance with, or in furtherance of calls for a boycott of Israel, can be considered as one type of evidence that a company is participating in a boycott of Israel when accompanied with the conduct described under subsection 1. Expressive activity alone, directed at a specific person or a government action, may not be considered evidence of a boycott of Israel.

4. This section does not apply to:

- a. A contract with a value of less than one hundred thousand dollars, and
- b. A contract with a company that has fewer than ten full-time employees.

5. Nothing in this section shall be construed in a manner that diminishes or infringes upon a right protected under the constitution of this state or the first amendment to the constitution of the United States."
