f. An organization with more than fifteen licensed sites under subsection b above may not increase its number of sites beyond the number of sites licensed as of January 1, 2023.

- 1. <u>the feasibility of restricting placement of electronic pull tab devices within a designated area</u> within the alcoholic beverage establishments. The study must consider:
  - a. <u>Limiting the location of electronic pull tab devices within established areas of a gaming site which are already required to be separated from a dining area based on gross sales of alcohol;</u>
  - b. The feasibility of creating barriers to limit the visibility and audibility of electronic pull tab devices within an alcoholic beverage establishment;
  - c. <u>Preventing minors from being able to access electronic pull tab devices within an alcoholic beverage establishment;</u>
  - d. An evaluation of whether the authorization of gambling sites and locations, limitations on gaming, and gaming play and conduct are properly enforced, fair, adequate, and appropriate.
