1 A BILL for an Act to to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-08.1 of the North Dakota

- 2 Century Code, relating to statewide political party campaign finance disclosures; to amend and
- 3 reenact subsection 7 of section 16.1-08.1-01-and, sections 16.1-08.1-02.3 and 16.1-08.1-02.4,
- 4 <u>subsection 3 of section 16.1-08.1-03.5</u>, and section 16.1-08.1-03.7 of the North Dakota Century
- 5 Code, relating to reporting of expenditures for political purposes; to provide for a legislative
- 6 <u>management study;</u> to provide a penalty; and to provide an appropriation.

15	SEC	TION 7. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ELECTION LAWS. During the
16	2023-24	interim, the legislative management shall consider studying provisions of the North
17	Dakota (	Century Code that relate to elections for purposes of eliminating duplicative provisions,
18	clarifying	g inconsistent or unclear provisions, pursuing uniformity for required contribution and
19	expendit	cure reports, and rearranging provisions in a logical order. The legislative management
20	shall rep	ort its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to

22	SEC	TION 8. APPROPRIATION - SECRETARY OF STATE - SYSTEM UPGRADES. There
23	is appro	priated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
24	appropri	ated, the sum of <del>\$20,000</del> <u>\$40,000</u> , or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the
25	secretar	y of state for the purpose of defraying costs associated with the necessary system
26	upgrade	s required by this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30,
27	2025.
