1 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Senate Rule 206 is amended as follows:

2 **206. Officers and employee positions of the Senate.** The following officers and
 3 employee positions are established, with the number, title, and manner of selection for each
 4 position as stated:

11 Committee and must be allocated to the majority and minority parties in proportion to each
12 party's percentage of the total number of the members-elect and each party shall appoint the
13 persons to the positions allocated to them, acting by and through the Employment Committee.
14 The majority party has the first right to select positions of a group until its allocation is filled.

15 The powers, duties, and qualifications for each officer or employee are as provided by law,
16 these rules, and the current Legislative Session Employee Handbook.

17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** House Rule 206 is amended as follows:

18 **206. Officers and employee positions of the House.** The following officers and employee
19 positions are established, with the number, title, and manner of selection for each position as

23 The Speaker and the Majority and Minority Leaders shall appoint their respective
24 administrative and staff assistants, acting by and through the Employment Committee.

25 Other employees must be appointed as determined necessary by the Employment
26 Committee and must be allocated to the majority and minority parties in proportion to each
27 party's percentage of the total number of the members-elect and each party shall appoint the
28 persons to the positions allocated to them, acting by and through the Employment Committee.
29 The majority party has the first right to select positions of a group until its allocation is filled.

30 The powers, duties, and qualifications for each officer or employee are as provided by law,
31 these rules, and the current Legislative Session Employee Handbook.
