### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

# 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN 5 LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying health
   care services in local correctional facilities. The study must include:
  - A review of current state and federal requirements of local correctional facilities regarding health care services;
    - b. A review of health care services funding patterns for local correctional facilities;
  - c. A consideration of the challenges of local health care facilities and providers in serving incarcerated individuals in local correctional facilities;
    - d. An analysis of models of best practices for health care services for incarcerated individuals in local correctional facilities; and
    - e. A consideration of methods to expand local, state, and federal funding for health care services in local correctional facilities.
  - The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations together
    with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth
    legislative assembly.
