- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of health and human services
- 2 for regional acute psychiatric treatment and residential supportive housing services.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - REGIONAL ACUTE PSYCHIATRIC TREATMENT AND
5	<b>RESIDENTIAL SUPPORTIVE HOUSING SERVICES.</b> There is appropriated out of any moneys
6	in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
7	\$64,000,000\$16,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of
8	health and human services for the purpose of providing facility and operations grants to improve
9	regional acute psychiatric treatment services and residential supportive housing, for the
10	biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The department may use the
11	funds provided in this section for the purpose of providing behavioral health grants to improve
12	facilities and operations. To be eligible to receive a grant under this section, a recipient shall
13	increase the number of inpatient behavioral health beds as determined by the department. The
14	beds must be for the purpose of providing acute psychiatric treatment or residential supportive
15	housing. The department shall require an entity receiving a grant to operate the behavioral
16	health facility for at least ten years and enter into a contract accordingly. Facility locations must
17	be based on options to eliminate or reduce the number of referrals to the state hospital. The
18	department shall distribute grants to ensure equal acute psychiatric treatment and residential
19	supportive housing services in each quadrant of the state.
