- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying historical health care mandates. The study must include:
 - a. An analysis of current health care mandates, including when they were enacted,
 the purpose, effectiveness, and present applicability;
 - b. A history of health care mandates and step therapy protocol; and
 - Input from the department of health and human services, the insurance department, the public employees retirement system, insurance providers and other stakeholders.
 - The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations together
 with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth
 legislative assembly.
