1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the

2 governor; and to provide for a report.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying
the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
June 30, 2027, as follows:

18 SECTION 2. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -

BUDGET SECTION REPORT. Subject to the limitations of this section, in addition to the amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated to the governor's office, any additional income from other funds, excluding federal funds, which may become available to the governor's office, for the period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. Any other funds received under this section must be used for the specific purpose intended for the funds or transferred to the appropriate state agency or institution. - 5 legislative assembly or from the emergency commission and budget section under chapter
