## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO

### HOUSE BILL NO. 1001

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the  
2 governor; to amend and reenact sections 54-07-04 and 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century  
3 Code, relating to salaries of the governor and lieutenant governor; and to provide for a report.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying  
8 the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending  
9 June 30, 2027, as follows:

**SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

**SEVENTIETH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act which are not included in the entity's base budget for the 2027-29 biennium and which the entity shall report to the appropriations committees of the seventieth legislative assembly regarding the use of this funding:

**SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST.** The governor's office may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.

**SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -**

**BUDGET SECTION REPORT.** Subject to the limitations of this section, in addition to the amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated to the governor's office, any additional income from other funds, excluding federal funds, which may become available to the governor's office, for the period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. Any other funds received under this section must be used for the specific purpose intended for the funds or transferred to the appropriate state agency or institution. Upon the receipt of other funds under this section, the governor's office shall provide a report to the budget section regarding the source, amount, and purpose of the funds received. Federal funds which may become

1 available to the governor's office may be accepted by the governor's office. Federal funds  
2 accepted by the governor's office may not be spent until authorization is received from the  
3 legislative assembly or from the emergency commission and budget section under chapter  
4 54-16.

5 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **54-07-04. Salary of governor.**

8 The annual salary of the governor is ~~one hundred fifty-two thousand two hundred sixty-five-~~  
9 ~~dollars through June 30, 2024, and one hundred fifty-eight thousand three hundred-~~  
10 ~~fifty-six~~one hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred seven dollars through June 30, 2026,  
11 and one hundred sixty-eight thousand dollars thereafter.

12 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
13 amended and reenacted as follows:

14 **54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor.**

15 The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is ~~one hundred thirty thousand dollars through-~~  
16 ~~June 30, 2024, and one hundred thirty-five thousand two hundred~~one hundred thirty-nine  
17 thousand two hundred fifty-six dollars through June 30, 2026, and one hundred forty-three  
18 thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars thereafter.
