ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1002

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 secretary of state; to amend and reenact sections 46-03-11, 46-04-01, 46-04-03, 46-04-04,

3 46-04-10, 46-04-14, 46-04-18, 46-04-19, and 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,

4 relating to public printing and the salary of the secretary of state; to provide for a transfer; and to

5 provide an exemption.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and
federal funds, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
June 30, 2027, as follows:

29	SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRAN	SFER REQUEST. The	
30	secretary of state may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item		

31 in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds

1 from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in accordance

2 with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as approved by the

3 sixty-ninth legislative assembly.

4 SECTION 4. OTHER FUNDS - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND.

5 The other funds line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$3,500,000 from the

6 strategic investment and improvements fund for election pollpad and cradle points replacement

7 and information technology system enhancements for the secretary of state.

8 SECTION 5. TRANSFER - GENERAL FUND - ELECTION FUND. The office of

9 management and budget may transfer up to \$600,000 from the general fund, appropriated in

10 the election reform line item in section 1 of this Act, to the election fund to match federal funds

11 received by the state, as requested by the secretary of state, during the biennium beginning

12 July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.

13 SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 46-03-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is

14 amended and reenacted as follows:

15 **46-03-11.** Publication of session laws and pocket supplements.

The secretary of state and the legislative council shall correct ministerial or clerical errors and supervise the publication of the session laws and pocket part supplements to this code in a manner and form prescribed by the legislative council, correlating each year's laws with this code.

SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

46-04-01. Official distribution of state laws - Secretary of stateLegislative council to control.

24 Each member of the legislative assembly and each, constitutional officer of the state, and 25 each judge of the supreme and district courts for the use of their respective offices and 26 departments is entitled to receive from the state a copy of any publication of the laws of the 27 state and of any compilation or codification thereofof the laws of the state published under 28 authority of the state. The district court in every county in the state is entitled to a copy of 29 such the publications. The codification of laws of the state received by each member of the 30 legislative assembly is subject to section 54-03-23. The secretary of statelegislative council 31 shall designate other offices and agencies of the state that are entitled to receive copies of any-

1 sucha publication of the laws for the use of suchthe state offices and agencies and also shall 2 determine the number of copies of any publication to be received by any recipient in a 3 distribution under the provisions of this section, if more than one copy is needed by such the 4 recipient for official use. All agencies that are funded entirely from special state funds or federal 5 funds must be charged for the actual cost of each copy of such the publications that the agency 6 requests. 7 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 46-04-03. Distribution of session laws, compilations, and codifications by secretary 10 of statelegislative council. 11 The secretary of state, as soon as conveniently can be done afterlegislative council shall. 12 distribute as provided in sections 46-04-01 and 46-04-02 the publication of any session laws, 13 compilations, or codifications, shall cause copies thereof to be distributed as provided in-14 sections 46-04-01 and 46-04-02 and copies of those documents, as soon as practicable. The 15 secretary of state, in addition, legislative council shall furnish to the legislative assembly such 16 additional copies as are necessary upon resolution of the respective branches or committees 17 thereofof the legislative assembly and shall furnish to each member of the legislative assembly, 18 upon demand thereforrequest, such current volumes of laws as have not been obtained by the 19 member through service in previous sessions. 20 SECTION 9. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 21 amended and reenacted as follows: 22 46-04-04. Session laws, compilations, and codifications remain property of state. 23 Except as otherwise provided by law, each copy of laws, compilations, or codifications 24 furnished to any officer, department, or agency of the state, or to the legislative assembly, its 25 officers, or committees is and must remain the property of the state and must be surrendered to 26 the secretary of statelegislative council or to the recipient's successor in office. 27 SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is 28 amended and reenacted as follows:

1 46-04-10. Duties of secretary of statelegislative council - Exchange of laws with other 2 states. 3 The secretary of statelegislative council may distribute copies of all laws passed by each 4 legislative assembly and all compilations or codifications of the same, whenever it seems-5 desirable laws passed by each legislative assembly: 6 1. In exchange for like publications of other states. 7 2. To replace copies lost or damaged in official use. 8 3. To provide copies as needed to state officers, boards, commissions, institutions, or 9 agencies of the state. 10 4. To provide copies as needed to the national conference of commissioners on uniform 11 state laws. 12 SECTION 11. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is 13 amended and reenacted as follows: 14 46-04-14. Secretary of stateLegislative council to forward laws to counties. 15 As soon as the laws of each session of the legislative assembly are printed and ready for 16 distribution, the secretary of statelegislative council shall forward those the laws to which each 17 county is entitled to the county auditor of the county. 18 SECTION 12. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is 19 amended and reenacted as follows: 20 46-04-18. Secretary of stateLegislative council to sell certain laws. 21 During the biennium immediately after publication, the secretary of statelegislative council 22 must shall sell copies of the session laws for the cost of publication and handling plus ten 23 percent. In subsequent bienniums, the secretary of statelegislative council may determine and 24 set a price for the copies of the session laws not sold in the biennium immediately after their 25 publication. The price set should maximize the recovery of the cost of publication and handling 26 and minimize the number of volumes subject to disposal under section 46-04-19. All moneys 27 received under the provisions of this section must be paid over to the state treasurer and 28 credited to the general fund. 29 SECTION 13. AMENDMENT. Section 46-04-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is

30 amended and reenacted as follows:

1 46-04-19. Secretary of state Legislative council may dispose of laws. 2 The secretary of statelegislative council may dispose of all volumes of the laws that are ten 3 or more years old, except one volume of each that, which must be retained for historical 4 purposes. 5 SECTION 14. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows: 7 54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. 8 The annual salary of the secretary of state is one hundred thirty thousand dollars through 9 June 30, 2024, and one hundred thirty-five thousand two hundred dollarsone hundred 10 thirty-nine thousand two hundred fifty-six dollars though June 30, 2026, and one hundred 11 forty-three thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars thereafter. 12 SECTION 15. EXEMPTION - STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND. The amount of 13 \$6,000,000 appropriated from federal funds derived from the state fiscal recovery fund for the 14 purposes of an election management system and to upgrade FirstStop in section 1 of 15 chapter 34 of the 2023 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended 16 funds from these projects are available to the secretary of state for costs relating to an election 17 management system and to upgrade FirstStop during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and 18 ending June 30, 2027. 19 SECTION 16. EXEMPTION - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND. 20 The amount of \$1,500,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements fund 21 for the purposes of a new campaign system, contracted website redesign, and information 22 technology enhancements in section 1 of chapter 34 of the 2023 Session Laws is not subject to 23 section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from these projects are available to the secretary 24 of state for costs relating to a new campaign system, contracted website redesign, and 25 information technology enhancements during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending 26 June 30, 2027.
