- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance
- 2 commissioner; to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-23.1 of the North Dakota
- 3 Century Code, relating to a government self-insurance pool report; to amend and reenact
- 4 section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the insurance

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from other funds derived from special funds and federal funds, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the insurance commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows:

NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The 8 insurance commissioner may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line 9 item in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer 10 funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in 11 accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as 12 approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly. 13 SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION - REPORTING. In addition to the 14 amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, any federal funds that become available are 15 appropriated to the insurance commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and 16 ending June 30, 2027. The insurance commissioner shall report any additional federal funds 17 under this section to the office of management and budget and the legislative council. 18 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is 19 amended and reenacted as follows: 20 26.1-01-09. Salary of commissioner. 21 The annual salary of the commissioner is one hundred thirty thousand dollars through-22 June 30, 2024, and one hundred thirty-five thousand two hundred dollarsthirty-nine thousand 23 two hundred fifty-six dollars through June 30, 2026, and one hundred forty-three thousand four 24 hundred thirty-four dollars thereafter. 25 **SECTION 6.** A new section to chapter 26.1-23.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 26 created and enacted as follows: 27 Government self-insurance pool - Report. 28 A government self-insurance pool organized under this chapter shall provide a report to the 29 legislative management by September thirtieth of each even-numbered year.
