## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
- 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
- 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of
- 7 defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,
- 8 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows:

## 16 SECTION 2. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The

- 17 Indian affairs commission may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool
- 18 line item in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to
- 19 transfer funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in
- 20 accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as
- 21 approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
