- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home;
- 2 to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 3 to meals provided to employees of the veterans' home; to provide an exemption; to provide for a
- 4 legislative management study; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds

as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and

federal funds, to the veterans' home for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the veterans'

10 home, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows:

21 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

22 **SEVENTIETH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding

1 items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act which are not included in the entity's 2 base budget for the 2027-29 biennium and which the entity shall report to the appropriations 3 committees of the seventieth legislative assembly regarding the use of this funding: 4 One-Time Funding Description Other Funds 5 Building maintenance \$390,000 6 Resident garages and storage units 175,000 7 22,050 Equipment 8 Total \$587,050 9 SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The 10 veterans' home may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item in 11 section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds 12 from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in accordance 13 with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as approved by the 14 sixty-ninth legislative assembly. 15 SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 37-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 16 and enacted as follows: 17 Meals provided to employees of the veterans' home. 18 In the event of a disruption of operations, the veterans' home may provide meals at a fair 19 value or without a charge to employees of the veterans' home as required by the job 20 assignments of the employees. 21 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - REPORT. Notwithstanding section 22 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget may transfer up to \$400,000 23 from special funds from the salaries and wages line item to the operating expenses line item in 24 section 1 of chapter 7 of the 2023 Session Laws, during the period beginning with the effective 25 date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2025, as requested by the veterans' home. The veterans' 26 home shall notify the legislative council of any transfers made pursuant to this section. 27 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - VETERANS' HOME FACILITIES. 28 During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the usage of the 29 veterans' home facilities. The study must consider any organizational changes necessary to 30 increase resident census at the veterans' home, potential uses for unoccupied space, and 31 federal requirements. The legislative management shall report its findings and

- 1 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 2 the seventieth legislative assembly.
- 3 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY.** Section 5 of this Act and the sum of \$175,000 appropriated
- 4 from the Melvin Norgard memorial fund for resident garages and storage units in the other
- 5 funds line item in section 1 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
