1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 career and technical education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and
federal funds, to the department of career and technical education for the purpose of defraying
the expenses of the department of career and technical education, for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows:

4 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

5 SEVENTIETH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
6 items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act which are not included in the entity's
7 base budget for the 2027-29 biennium and which the entity shall report to the appropriations
8 committees of the seventieth legislative assembly regarding the use of this funding:

SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The department of career and technical education may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the salaries and wages line item in accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill

17 No. 1015, as approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.

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SECTION 4. WORKFORCE TRAINING GRANTS - SALARIES AND WAGES EXPENSES.

The workforce training line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$500,000 from the general fund which the department of career and technical education shall distribute to each eligible organization in the state dedicated to expanding workforce opportunities, training, and education for the purpose of defraying salaries and wages expenses of the organization's

23 employees. The department of career and technical education shall distribute the funding

24 identified in this section as follows:

25	1.	An organization in the northwest region of the state	\$230,000
