4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-10-04. Publication of false information in political advertisements - Penalty.

- 8 A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that the person knowingly, or with 1. 9 reckless disregard for its truth or falsity, publishes anya political advertisement or news 10 release that contains anycontaining an assertion, representation, or statement of fact, 11 including information concerning a candidate's prior public record, which is untrue, 12 deceptive, or misleading, whether on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for 13 public office, initiated measure, referred measure, constitutional amendment, or any 14 other issue, question, or proposal on an election ballot, and whether the 15 publicationwhich is published by radio, television, newspaper, text message, telephone 16 <u>call</u>, pamphlet, folder, display cards, signs, posters, billboard advertisements, 17 websites, electronic transmission, social media, or by any other public means or 18 commercial medium.
 - 2. This section does not apply to a newspaper, television or radio station, or other commercial medium that is not the source of the political advertisement or news release.
