- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the opportunity to provide public comment at a meeting of a public
- 3 entity.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Public comment Regular meetings of political subdivisions.</u>
- At least one-fourth of the publicly noticed regular meetings of a political subdivision
   held per year must include an opportunity for an individual in attendance to provide
- 10 <u>public comment.</u>
- 2. An individual providing comment at a meeting shall provide to the political subdivision
   in writing the individual's name and address.
- 13 3. A political subdivision may:
- 14 <u>a. Limit a public comment by time per speaker, total time for public comment, or</u>
   both.
- b. Develop a policy regarding public comment rules for regular meetings. The policy
   may provide a public comment:
- 18 (1) Must be pertinent to the political subdivision.
- 19 (2) May not interfere with the orderly conduct of the regular meeting.
- 20 (3) May not be defamatory, abusive, harassing, or unlawful.
- 21 (4) <u>May be prohibited if an alternative procedure exists to bring that particular</u>
  22 type of public comment before the political subdivision, the public comment

- 1 <u>includes confidential or exempt information, or the public comment is</u>
- 2 <u>otherwise prohibited by law.</u>
