SENATE BILL NO. 2101
(Senator Beard)
(Representative Richter)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 23-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to emergency medical services response requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 23-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

1. An emergency medical services operation ~~within this state~~ may not operate unless ~~the operation is licensed in accordance with~~under this chapter and The department shall adopt rules adopted by the department of health and human services. The rules for standards for operators which must include:
 - a. ~~Time when operator's services must be available;~~
 - b. Requirements for services to ensure a reliable response to 911 and emergent interfacility transports, while providing nonemergent services;
 - c. ~~Type of motor vehicle operator's license needed for drivers of ground vehicles;~~
 - e.d. ~~Training standards for operation personnel;~~
 - d.e. ~~Equipment and ground vehicle standards;~~
 - e.f. ~~Annual license fees;~~
 - f.g. ~~Number of personnel required for each run;~~
 - g.h. ~~The scope of practice for uncertified drivers, certified personnel, and emergency medical services professionals;~~
 - h.i. ~~Performance standards, which may include response time standards;~~ and
 - i.j. ~~Other requirements as may be found necessary to carry out the intent~~requirements of this chapter.
