### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

### 4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -

### 5 **GRANT FUNDING FOR ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING CARE FOR THE ELDERLY.** There is

appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
appropriated, the sum of \$250,000\$200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to
the department of health and human services for the purpose of increasingproviding grant
funding to organizations that provide care to the elderly in rural areas of the state, for the

- 10 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. Of the grant funding provided
- 11 <u>under this section, \$100,000 must be provided to existing organizations providing care to elderly</u>
- 12 individuals in rural areas of the state and \$100,000 must be provided to organizations to provide
- 13 services to elderly individuals in one or more rural counties in the state which do not currently
- 14 <u>have these services for elderly individuals.</u>
