- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to mobile barber shop requirements; to amend and reenact sections
- 3 43-04-01, 43-04-42, 43-04-44, and 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 4 mobile barbershops and the associated fees, inspection rights, and penalties; and to provide a
- 5 penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:

9 **43-04-01. Definitions.**

- 10 In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 11 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. <u>"Mobile barbershop" means a barbershop operated in a mobile vehicle or mobile</u>
- 13 <u>structure for the exclusive use of practicing barbering services performed by a</u>
 14 licensed barber.
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
 16 when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
 17 the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
 18 either directly or indirectly:
- 19 a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.
- b. Giving facial or scalp massages or treatments with oils, creams, lotions, or other
 preparations either by hand or mechanical appliances.
- 22 c. Singeing, shampooing, or dyeing the hair or applying hair tonics.
- 23 d. Applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays, or lotions to
 24 scalp, face, neck, or upper part of the body.

12		e.	For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each					
13			shop owner in advance.

15			43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars.					
16		g.	For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in					
17			addition to the annual license fee.					
18		h.	For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-five dollars.					
19	2.	Eac	Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied					
20		by a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be						
21		retained by the board and deposited as other fees.						
22	3.	A duplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon:						
23		a.	Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss;					
24		b.	Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and					
25		C.	Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate.					
26	4.	Any	one who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of					
27		war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as						
28		to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the						
29		rest	oration fee.
