- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to mobile barber shop requirements; to amend and reenact sections
- 3 43-04-01, 43-04-42, 43-04-44, and 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 4 mobile barbershops and the associated fees, inspection rights, and penalties; and to provide a
- 5 penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **43-04-01. Definitions.**
 - In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 11 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. "Mobile barbershop" means a barbershop operated in a mobile vehicle, trailer, or
- mobile structure for the exclusive use of practicing barbering services performed by a
- 14 <u>licensed barber.</u>
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
- when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
- the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
- 18 either directly or indirectly:
- a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.

AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows: 8 43-04-42. Fees. 9 The board may charge applicants the following fees: 10 For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one 11 hundred dollars. 12 b. For renewal of a master barber's certificate, one hundred dollars. 13 For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a twenty dollar penalty 14 fee in addition to the regular renewal fee. 15 For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred d. 16 twenty-five dollars. 17 For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each e. 18 shop owner in advance. 19 For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section 20 43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars. 21 For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in g. 22 addition to the annual license fee. 23 For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-five dollars. 24 2. Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied 25 by a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be 26 retained by the board and deposited as other fees. 27 3. A duplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon: 28 Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss; a. 29 b. Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and

Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate.

5	<u>5.</u>	Each application to open or establish a mobile barbershop must be accompanied by a			
6		fee of one hundred fifty dollars for initial registration. Renewal of a mobile barbershop			
7		certificate must be accompanied by a fee of one hundred dollars.			
8	SEC	CTION 3. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created			
9	and enacted as follows:				
10	Mobile barbershop - Regulations - Requirements.				
11	<u>1.</u>	An individual may operate a mobile barbershop if:			
12		a. The individual is a licensed barber under section 43-04-32; and			
13		b. The mobile barbershop is registered with the board.			
14	<u>2.</u>	The board shall adopt rules regulating mobile barbershops. The rules adopted by the			
15		board must regulate water, wastewater, power, safety, sanitation, equipment, services,			
16		location, reports, and any other requirements deemed necessary. The board may			
17		proscribe reasonable penalties, fines, and fees necessary to enforce the regulation of			
18		mobile barbershops.			
19	3. To register a mobile barbershop with the board, the owner shall:				
20		a. Pay the required registration fee;			
21	1	b. Comply with all applicable laws, rules, and ordinances; and			
22	!	Maintain a suitable motor vehicle or trailer that is:			
23		(1) Self-contained, self-supporting, and enclosed; and			
24		(2) At least sixteen feet [4.88 meters] in length; and			
25		(3) Not a towed unit or trailer.			
26	<u>4.</u>	Each motor vehicle or trailer used as a mobile barbershop must be registered with the			
27	board.				
28	5. An individual who holds a mobile barbershop registration shall:				
29		a. Maintain a permanent address for receiving correspondence with the board;			
30		b. Display the name and registration number of the mobile barbershop on a			
31		conspicuous exterior surface;			

1		<u>C.</u>	Supply the board with the make, model, vehicle identification number, and license	
2			plate number of the vehicle, trailer, or mobile structure used as a mobile	
3			barbershop; and	
4		<u>d.</u>	Comply with all rules adopted by the board.	
5	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-44 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
6	amended and reenacted as follows:			
7	43-04-44. Inspection of barbershops and barber schools.			
8	Any member of the board or any of its inspectors, agents, or assistants may enter and			
9	inspect any barbershop, mobile barbershop, or barber school at any time during business			
10	hours.			
11	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
12	amended and reenacted as follows:			
13	43-04-45. Penalty.			
14	Any person who shall:			
15	1.	<u>An</u>	individual is guilty of a class B misdemeanor if the individual:	
16		<u>a.</u>	Violate Violates any of the provisions provision of sections section 43-04-21,	
17			43-04-30, and 43-04-43, or section 3 of this Act;	
18	2.	<u>b.</u>	PermitPermits any personindividual in that person's individual's employ,	
19			supervision, or control to practice as a barber unless the person employed,	
20			supervised, or controlled individual has a certificate of registration as a registered	
21			barber;	
22	3.	<u>C.</u>	Obtain Obtains or attemptattempts to obtain a certificate of registration by the	
23			payment of money other than the required fee, or any other thing of value, or by	
24			fraudulent misrepresentations;

26			misrepresentations; or	
27	5.	<u>e.</u>	Willfully failfails to display a certificate of registration as is required by this
