- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to mobile barber shop requirements; to amend and reenact sections
- 3 43-04-01, 43-04-42, 43-04-44, and 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 4 mobile barbershops and the associated fees, inspection rights, and penalties; and to provide a
- 5 penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **43-04-01. Definitions.**
- In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 11 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. "Mobile barbershop" means a barbershop operated in a mobile vehicle, trailer, or
- mobile structure for the exclusive use of practicing barbering services performed by a
- 14 licensed barber.
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
- when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
- the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
- 18 either directly or indirectly:
- a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.
- b. Giving facial or scalp massages or treatments with oils, creams, lotions, or other
- 21 preparations either by hand or mechanical appliances.
- c. Singeing, shampooing, or dyeing the hair or applying hair tonics.

1		d.	Applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays, or lotions to
2			scalp, face, neck, or upper part of the body.
3	SEC	TIOI	N 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is
4	amended	d and	d reenacted as follows:
5	43-0	4-42	. Fees.
6	1.	The	board may charge applicants the following fees:
7		a.	For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one
8			hundred dollars.
9		b.	For renewal of a master barber's certificate, one hundred dollars.
10		C.	For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a twenty dollar penalty
11			fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.
12		d.	For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred
13			twenty-five dollars.
14		e.	For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each
15			shop owner in advance.
16		f.	For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section
17			43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars.
18		g.	For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in
19			addition to the annual license fee.
20		h.	For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-five dollars.
21	2.	Eac	h application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied
22		by a	a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be
23		reta	ined by the board and deposited as other fees.
24	3.	A dı	uplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon:
25		a.	Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss;
26		b.	Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and
27		C.	Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate.
28	4.	Any	one who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of
29		war	, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as
30		to p	ayment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the
31		rest	oration fee.

1	<u>5.</u>	Each application to open or establish a mobile barbershop must be accompanied by a							
2		fee of one hundred fifty dollars for initial registration. Renewal of a mobile barbershop							
3		certificate must be accompanied by a fee of one hundred dollars.							
4	SEC	ECTION 3. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created							
5	and ena	cted as follows:							
6	Mok	oile barbershop - Regulations - Requirements.							
7	<u>1.</u>	An individual may operate a mobile barbershop if:							
8		a. The individual is a licensed barber under section 43-04-32; and							
9		b. The mobile barbershop is registered with the board.							
10	<u>2.</u>	The board shall adopt rules regulating mobile barbershops. The rules adopted by the							
11		board must regulate water, wastewater, power, safety, sanitation, equipment, services,							
12		location, reports, and any other requirements deemed necessary. The board may							
13		proscribe reasonable penalties, fines, and fees necessary to enforce the regulation of							
14		mobile barbershops.							
15	<u>3.</u>	To register a mobile barbershop with the board, the owner shall:							
16		a. Pay the required registration fee;							
17		b. Comply with all applicable laws, rules, and ordinances; and							
18		c. Maintain a suitable motor vehicle or trailer that is:							
19		(1) Self-contained, self-supporting, and enclosed; and							
20		(2) At least sixteen feet [4.88 meters] in length.							
21	<u>4.</u>	Each motor vehicle or trailer used as a mobile barbershop must be registered with the							
22		board.							
23	<u>5.</u>	An individual who holds a mobile barbershop registration shall:							
24		a. Maintain a permanent address for receiving correspondence with the board;							
25		b. Display the name and registration number of the mobile barbershop on a							
26		conspicuous exterior surface;							
27		c. Supply the board with the make, model, vehicle identification number, and license							
28		plate number of the vehicle, trailer, or mobile structure used as a mobile							
29		barbershop; and							
30		d. Comply with all rules adopted by the board.

15			supervision, or control to practice as a barber unless the person employed,			
16			supervised, or controlled individual has a certificate of registration as a registered

19			payment of money other than the required fee, or any other thing of value, or by			
20			fraudulent misrepresentations;
