- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new sections to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restricted, temporary, and retired barber licenses; to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 43-04-01, 43-04-04, 43-04-06, 43-04-30, 43-04-30.1, 43-04-32, and 43-04-42
- 4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the board of barber examiners, barber licensing,
- 5 continuing education, and fees; and to provide a penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **43-04-01. Definitions.**

- 10 In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. "Licensed barber" means a licensee who has:
 - a. Met the requirements defined in sections 43-04-31 and 43-04-32; and
- b. Passed the examination required in section 43-04-33.
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
 16 when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
 17 the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
- 18 either directly or indirectly:
- a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.
- 5. Giving facial or scalp massages or treatments with oils, creams, lotions, or other
 preparations either by hand or mechanical appliances.
- c. Singeing, shampooing, or dyeing the hair or applying hair tonics.
- d. Applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays, or lotions to scalp, face, neck, or upper part of the body.

1	<u>4.</u>	"Restricted barber" means a licensee, limited in practice to specific areas in which			
2		competence has been demonstrated, and allowed to work in a licensed host shop.			
3	<u>5.</u>	"Retired barber" means a licensee who meets the requirements of section 9 of this			
4		Act.			
5	<u>6.</u>	"Temporary barber" means an eligible licensee who is permitted to practice under the			
6		supervision of a licensed barber until results are available from the the next scheduled			
7		examination.			
8	SEC	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
9	amende	d and reenacted as follows:			
10	43-0	4-04. Board of barber examiners - Appointment - Term of office - Qualifications.			
11	<u>1.</u>	The board of barber examiners must consist of at least three members, each of whom-			
12		must be appointed by the governor for a term of three years.			
13	<u>2.</u>	Members are subject to the following requirements:			
14		<u>a.</u> The terms of office of the members must be so arranged that one term expires on			
15		the thirty-first day of December of each year-;			
16		<u>b.</u> Each appointment must be made from a list of five names submitted to the			
17		governor by the state barber association , ; and each			
18		c. Each member must be a registered barber who has followed the occupation of			
19		barber in this state for at least five years prior to before that member's			
20		appointment.			
21	<u>3.</u>	Two additional members, who are not required to be licensed barbers, may be			
22		appointed by the board for tasks including:			
23		a. New and annual shop inspections;			
24		b. Legal advice; and			
25		c. Office duties.

Section 43-04-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is 4 amended and reenacted as follows: 5 43-04-32. BarberLicensed barber - Application for examination. 6 Any person who desires to take the examination for a certificate of registration to 7 practice as a registered barber shall make application to the board on blanks prepared 8 and furnished by the board and shall enclose with the application all of the following: 9 Proof, under oath, of the person's qualifications. 10 2. A five-inch by three-inch [12.7-centimeter by 7.62-centimeter] signed photograph of 11 that person. The person also shall present such a photograph to the board when the 12 person appears for examination. 13 The required fee. 3. 14 4. 5		<u>b.</u>	Must begin from the verified date of graduation or completion of training; and			
6		<u>c.</u>	May be exercised only under the supervision of a licensed barber until results are			
7			available from the next scheduled examination.			
8	<u>3.</u>	If th	e temporary license holder fails the examination, the temporary license holder may			
9		<u>app</u>	ly for an extension of the individual's license under this chapter, pay the fee, and

24	<u>1.</u>	<u>An i</u>	ndividual may apply for a retired barber license and practice in a limited capacity if			
25		the	applicant is:			
26		<u>a.</u>	At least sixty-five years of age or has been practicing a minimum of twenty years			
27			as a licensed barber; and			
28		<u>b.</u>	Works no more than five days per month.			
29	<u>2.</u>	<u>Upc</u>	on an applicant meeting the qualifications under this section and paying the initial			
licensing fee, the board shall issue a retired			nsing fee, the board shall issue a retired barber license.			

1 SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 43-04-42. Fees. 4 The board may charge applicants the following fees: 5 For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one 6 hundred dollars. 7 For renewal of a master barber's certificate, one hundred dollars. b. 8 For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a twenty dollar penalty C. 9 fee in addition to the regular renewal fee. 10 For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred d. 11 twenty-five dollars. 12 For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each 13 shop owner in advance. 14 For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section 15 43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars. 16 For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in g. 17 addition to the annual license fee. 18 For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-fivetwo hundred fifty dollars. 19 2. Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied 20 by a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be 21 retained by the board and deposited as other fees. 22 3. A duplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon: 23 Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss; a. 24 b. Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and 25 C. Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate. 26 Anyone who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of 27 war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as 28 to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the 29 restoration fee.
