- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new sections to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restricted, temporary, and retired barber licenses; to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 43-04-01, 43-04-04, 43-04-06, 43-04-30, 43-04-30.1, 43-04-32, and 43-04-42
- 4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the board of barber examiners, barber licensing,
- 5 continuing education, and fees; and to provide a penalty.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **43-04-01. Definitions.**

- 10 In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 11 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. "Licensed barber" means a licensee who has:
  - a. Met the requirements defined in sections 43-04-31 and 43-04-32; and
- b. <u>Passed the examination required in section 43-04-33.</u>
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
- when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
- the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
- 18 either directly or indirectly:
- a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.

AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 14 amended and reenacted as follows: 15 43-04-04. Board of barber examiners - Appointment - Term of office - Qualifications. 16 The board of barber examiners must consist of at least three members, each of whom-<u>1.</u> 17 must be appointed by the governor for a term of three years. <u>2.</u> 18 Members are subject to the following requirements: 19 The terms of office of the members must be so arranged that one term expires on <u>a.</u> 20 the thirty-first day of December of each year. 21 <u>b.</u> Each appointment must be made from a list of five names submitted to the 22 governor by the state barber association; and each 23 Each member must be a registered barber who has followed the occupation of 24 barber in this state for at least five years prior to before that member's 25 appointment. 26 <u>3.</u> Two additional members, who are shall serve as nonvoting ex officio members and are 27 not required to be licensed barbers, may be appointed by the board for tasks 28 including: 29 New and annual shop inspections; a. 30 b. Legal advice; and 31 c. Office duties.

1 Accreditation hours may be completed through a variety of continuing education 2 forums, including seminars, workshops, annual conventions, and video courses. 3 2. The board may suspend, revoke, place on probationary status, impose a fine on, or 4 refuse to renew any license issued under this chapter if the licensee fails to meet the 5 continuing education requirements established by the board. 6 An applicant for accreditation of continuing education courses, classes, or activities 7 may be charged a reasonable fee determined by the board. 8 SECTION 6. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 14 and enacted as follows: 15 Temporary barber license - Requirements. 16 An individual who has met the requirements in subsection 2 of section 43-04-32 may <u>1.</u> 17 apply for and be issued a temporary barber license, upon payment of the required fee. 18 <u>2.</u> A license under this section: 19 Is valid for a maximum of three months; <u>a.</u> 20 Must begin from the verified date of graduation or completion of training; and <u>b.</u> 21 May be exercised only under the supervision of a licensed barber until results are <u>C.</u> 22 available from the next scheduled examination. 23 If the temporary license holder fails the examination, the temporary license holder may <u>3.</u> 24 apply for an extension of the individual's license under this chapter, pay the fee, and 25 register for the next scheduled examination. 26 SECTION 9. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 27 and enacted as follows: 28 Retired barber license - Requirements. 29 An individual may apply for a retired barber license and practice in a limited capacity if 30 the applicant is:

4. Anyone who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the restoration fee.
