- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-06-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to transgender student accommodations and restroom use in public schools; to provide
- 3 a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-06-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 7 15.1-06-21. Transgender student accommodations <u>- Restroom use - Enforcement -</u> 8 <u>Penalty</u>.

- A board of a school district, public school, or public school teacher may not adopt a
   policy that requires or prohibits anyor guidelines, whether implicit or explicit, requiring
   or prohibiting an individual from using a student's preferred gender pronoun.
- A board of a school district shall establish, with the approval of the parent or legal
   guardian, a plan for the use of a separate restroom accommodation for a transgender
   student.
- A board of a school district or a public school shall prohibit a student from using a
  restroom that does not coincide with the student's biological sex.
- 17 4. <u>A restroom or shower room on school grounds, which is accessible by multiple</u>
- 18 individuals at one time, must be designated for use exclusively for males or exclusively
- 19 for females and may be used only by members of the designated sex. Multi-stall
- 20 gender neutral restrooms and shower rooms are prohibited.
- 5. Unless otherwise required by law, a school district, public school, or public school
   teacher may not:

10		<u>C.</u>	Applying to a district court for an order enforcing the subpoena or other
11			investigation demand.
12	<u>7.</u>	For a	a violation of this section, the attorney general may seek and obtain a declaratory
13		judgr	ment or injunction in district court which prohibits the board of a school district, a
14		publi	c school, or a public school teacher from continuing the unlawful practice.
15	<u>8.</u>	The o	court may assess a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed two thousand five
16		<u>hund</u>	Ired dollars for each violation of this section.
17 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
