- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to false political advertisements; and to provide a penalty.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1	-10-04. Publication of false information in political advertisements - Penalty.
<u>1.</u>	A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that the person knowingly, or with
	reckless disregard for its truth or falsity, publishes anya political advertisement or news
	release that contains any containing an assertion, representation, or statement of fact,
	including information concerning a candidate's prior public record, which is untrue,
	deceptive, or misleading, whether on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for
	public office, initiated measure, referred measure, constitutional amendment, or any
	other issue, question, or proposal on an election ballot, and whether the
	publicationwhich is published by radio, television, newspaper, text message, telephone
	call, pamphlet, folder, display cards, signs, posters, billboard advertisements,
	websites, electronic transmission, <u>social media,</u> or <del>by</del> any other public means <u>or</u>
	commercial medium.
<u>2.</u>	This section does not apply to a newspaper, television or radio station, or other
	commercial medium that is not the source of the political advertisement or news

1	<u>3.</u>	A candidate who is the subject of an untrue, deceptive, or misleading advertisement
2		under this section may commence a civil action to recover civil damages. A candidate
3		who successfully recovers civil damages under this section mustmay be awarded the
4		full amount of all costs and attorney's fees incurred by the candidate during the
5		pendency of the civil proceedings.
