- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of an office of entrepreneurship; to provide for a
- 3 legislative management report; and to provide an appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

- Office of entrepreneurship Duties Report.
- 8 <u>1. As used in this section:</u>

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- a. "Business" means a corporation, partnership, company, cooperative, sole proprietorship, or other legal entity organized or operating for pecuniary or nonpecuniary gain.
- b. "Entrepreneur" means an individual who initiates and assumes the financial risk
  of a business.
  - c. "State agency" means an agency, board, commission, bureau, office,
    department, institution, and any other state governmental entity. The term
    excludes the legislative and judicial branches of state government.
- - a. Work to strengthen policies and programs supporting the growth of entrepreneurship in the state, including across demographic segments and geographic areas.

25	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - OFFICE OF				
26	ENTRE	PREI	NEUR	SHIP - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS. There is appropriated out of	
27	any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of				
28	\$485,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the				
29	purpose of providing salaries and benefits for office of entrepreneurship staff, for the biennium				
30	beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The department of commerce is authorized				
31	two full-time equivalent positions to administer the office of entrepreneurship.
