- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to nonresident upland and small game licenses; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 20.1-03-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident hunting
- 4 licenses.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:

8 Nonresident upland and small game license.

9 Except as provided in section 20.1-08-04.9, a nonresident may purchase a nonresident

10 upland and small game license to hunt upland and small game, excluding waterfowl, during the

11 <u>entire upland and small game hunting seasons. The governor, in the governor's proclamation,</u>

12 may specify the number of licenses that may be issued and the manner in which licenses are to

13 be issued.

14 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

15 amended and reenacted as follows:

16 **20.1-03-07.** Licenses to hunt, trap, or fish required of nonresidents.

- 17 <u>1.</u> Nonresidents, except as provided in sections 20.1-02-05, 20.1-03-07.3, and
 20.1-03-08, may not:
- 191.a.Hunt, catch, take, or kill any small game without a nonresident small game20license. The nonresident small game license entitles the nonresident to hunt-
- 21 small game for any period of fourteen consecutive days or any two periods of
- 22 seven consecutive days each. The hunting period for which the license is valid
- 23 must be designated on the license. A nonresident small game license is not
- 24 required to hunt waterfowl under section 20.1-03-07.1 or wild turkeys under

1			section 20.1-04-07. A nonresident may purchase more than one nonresident
2			small game license per year.
3	2.	<u>b.</u>	Trap, catch, attempt to catch, take, or kill any protected fur-bearing animal,
4			except that nonresidents holding a valid nonresident fur-bearer and nongame
5			hunting license may hunt only fox and coyote and except that residents of a state
6			that allows North Dakota residents to trap within that state may purchase a
7			nonresident reciprocal trapping license to trap in this state. However, a
8			nonresident holding a valid nonresident reciprocal trapping license may not trap,
9			catch, attempt to catch, take, or kill bobcats.
10	3.	<u>C.</u>	Catch, attempt to catch, take, or kill any fish without having a nonresident fishing
11			license.
12	4.	<u>d.</u>	Hunt, catch, take, or kill any unprotected bird or animal without having a
13			nonresident nongame hunting license or nonresident fur-bearer and nongame
14			hunting license.
15	5.	<u>e.</u>	Hunt, catch, take, or kill any big game animal without having the respective
16			nonresident big game license.
17	<u>2.</u>	Eac	h violation of this section is a distinct and separate offense.
