1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study regarding the regulation of  
2 cell-cultured protein.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - REGULATION OF**

5 **CELL-CULTURED PROTEIN.** During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall  
6 consider studying cell-cultured protein and the status of litigation in federal and state courts to  
7 prohibit cell-cultured protein. The study must include the outcome of litigation in other states and  
8 an analysis of the regulatory landscape, stakeholder impact, and feasibility of adopting a  
9 prohibition on cell-cultured protein in the state. The legislative management shall report its  
10 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the  
11 recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
