## SENATE BILL NO. 2238

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 47-32 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to <u>expungementsealing</u> of eviction records.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 47-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows: 6 ExpungementSealing of records - Nonpayment of rent - Damage to property - Victim 7 of domestic violence. 8 A person subject to a court order for eviction under this chapter for nonpayment of rent <u>1.</u> 9 or damage to the leased premises, who has resolved all nonpayment of rent and 10 damage claims, may move to have all court records relating to the eviction 11 proceedings expunded seven years after the order for eviction has been 12 satisfied, provided the person has not been evicted from another property during the 13 seven years following the eviction. 14 An individual who was subjected to domestic violence as defined under section 2. 15 14-07.1-01 at the time of the victim's tenancy and was evicted from that tenancy 16 because of a domestic violence incident may move to have all court records relating to 17 the eviction proceedings expunged sealed upon the conviction of the assailant for 18 domestic violence or the issuance of a disorderly conduct restraining order, sexual 19 assault restraining order, or domestic violence protection order against the assailant.
