- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 15 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the creation of the army forces reserve component scholarship program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Definitions**.
- 7 For purposes of this chapter:
- 8 <u>1. "Active duty" means full-time service pursuant to an executive order of the president of</u>
  9 the United States or the governor or an act of the congress of the United States.
- 10 <u>2.</u> "Institution of higher education" means an institution at which the applicant is enrolled
- 11 <u>in:</u>
- 12 <u>a.</u> A degree-granting program, whether the institution is under the control of the
   state board of higher education or privately controlled;
- b. An in-state nursing education program approved by the North Dakota board of
   nursing; or
- 16 <u>c. A program for a high-demand occupation identified under subsection 3 of section</u>
   17 15-10-38.1.
- 18 <u>Army forces reserve component scholarship program State board of higher</u>

- 20 <u>1. The state board of higher education shall:</u>
- 21 <u>a. Administer the army forces reserve component scholarship program.</u>
- b. Approve all eligible applicants.
- c. Process applications for the scholarship in the order received.
- 24 <u>d. Provide scholarships regardless of the financial need of the applicant.</u>

1	<u>2.</u>	The board may not grant priority to an applicant based on sex, race, or religion.			
2	<u>Elig</u>	gible applicant - Eligibility units.			
3	<u>1.</u>	An eligible applicant:			
4		<u>a.</u>	Is a member of a reserve component of the United States army, navy, marine		
5			corps, air force, coast guard, or space force in the state;		
6		<u>b.</u>	Is enrolled as a full-time student at an institution of higher education;		
7		<u>C.</u>	Does not possess a baccalaureate degree; and		
8		<u>d.</u>	Has not received financial assistance under chapters 37-07.1 or 37-07.2.		
9	<u>2.</u>	<u>An i</u>	ndividual who is discharged from a branch of the armed forces under other than		
10		<u>hon</u>	orable conditions is not eligible for a scholarship under this chapter.		
11	<u>3.</u>	A re	cipient of the scholarship may receive a scholarship for no more than forty-eight		
12		<u>eligi</u>	ibility units.		
13	<u>4.</u>	<u>For</u>	purposes of this section, twelve or more credit hours in an academic term equals:		
14		<u>a.</u>	Twelve eligibility units, if the term is a semester.		
15		<u>b.</u>	Eight eligibility units, if the term is a quarter.		
16	<u>Sch</u>	olarship amounts.			
17	<u>1.</u>	Subject to legislative appropriations, the state board of higher education shall pay on			
18		behalf of an eligible applicant:			
19		<u>a.</u>	An amount equal to one hundred percent of the tuition charged by the institution,		
20			if an eligible applicant is enrolled at an institution of higher education under the		
21			control of the state board of higher education; or		
22		<u>b.</u>	The lesser of an amount equal to:		
23			(1) One hundred percent of the tuition charged by the institution; or		
24			(2) The average tuition of all institutions of higher education under the control of		
25			the state board of higher education.		
26	<u>2.</u>	<u>The</u>	state board of higher education may require:		
27		<u>a.</u>	An applicant to apply for federal educational financial assistance programs,		
28			including programs offered by the United States department of defense, for which		
29			an applicant is eligible based on the applicant's military service.		

1		<u>b.</u>	Other financial assistance received by a scholarship recipient be applied to			
2			eligible expenses before scholarship funds awarded under this section may be			
3			applied to the remaining eligible expenses of the recipient.			
4	Active duty - Effects.					
5	If an eligible applicant is called to active duty and as a result withdraws or otherwise fails to					
6	complete courses for which scholarships have been awarded under this chapter:					
7	<u>1.</u>	The	institution of higher education shall grant the individual a leave of absence from			
8		the	individual's education program and may not impose an academic penalty for			
9		with	ndrawal or failure to complete courses.			
10	<u>2.</u>	<u>lf a</u>	scholarship for the courses has already been paid, the state board of higher			
11		<u>edu</u>	cation:			
12		<u>(a)</u>	May not add the eligibility units for the term to the individual's accumulated			
13			eligibility units, and the institution of higher education shall repay the scholarship			
14			amount to the state; or			
15		<u>(b)</u>	Shall add the eligibility units for the term to the individual's accumulated eligibility			
16			units as usual, if the institution of higher education agrees to allow the individual			
17			to complete the remainder of the courses in which the individual was enrolled at			
18			the time the individual was called to active duty.			
19	State board of higher education - Rules.					
20	<u>The</u>	The state board of higher education may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 28-32 necessary				
21	to implement and administer this chapter.
