- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections <u>39-10-03.1 and</u> <u>39-21-26</u> of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to <u>class B authorized emergency vehicles and</u> special

3 restrictions on lamps on motor vehicles or equipment.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-10-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is					
6	amended and reenacted as follows:					
7	39-10-03.1. Class B authorized emergency vehicles.					
8	1.	The driver of a class B authorized emergency vehicle may:				
9		a.	Park or stand, irrespective of the provisions of this chapter.			
10		b.	Exceed the speed limit so long as the driver does not endanger life or property			
11			during the time of a local or national disaster.			
12		C.	Disregard regulations governing direction of movement or turning in specified			
13			directions.			
14	2.	The	e exceptions granted in this section to a class B authorized emergency vehicle			
15	apply only when the authorized emergency vehicle is displaying an amber and white					
16	light visible under normal atmospheric conditions for a distance of five hundred feet					
17	[152.4 meters] in any direction, and:					
18		a.	When it is necessary for the authorized emergency vehicle to use these			
19			exemptions for the immediate protection of life or property;

1		b. Wł	hen an authorized emergency vehicle is stopped on a highway for the purpose			
2		of	performing a duty as required of the driver; or			
3		c. Wł	hen traveling at a speed slower than the normal flow of traffic.			
4	3.	A class	B authorized emergency vehicle may display a flashing blue light when the			
5		vehicle is stopped on a highway. A class B authorized emergency vehicle may not				
6		display a flashing blue light when transporting another vehicle or when traveling on a				
7		highway.				
8	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is					
9	amended and reenacted as follows:					
10	39-21-26. Special restrictions on lamps.					
11	1.	Any ligh	nted lamp or illuminating device upon<u>on</u> a motor vehicle, other than headlamps,			
12		spot lan	nps, auxiliary lamps, flashing turn signals, emergency vehicle warning lamps			
13		and sch	noolbus warning lamps, which projects a beam of light of an intensity greater			
14		than thr	ree hundred candlepower must be so directed <u>so</u> that no part of the			
15		high-inte	ensity portion of the beam will strike the level of the roadway on which the			
16		vehicle stands at a distance of more than seventy-five feet [22.86 meters] from the				
17		vehicle.				
18	2.	NoA person may not drive or move any vehicle or equipment uponon any highway with				
19		anya lamp or device thereon displaying a red or green light visible from directly in front				
20		of the center thereof<u>of</u> the vehicle or equipment . This section does not apply to any a				
21		vehicle upon which a red light visible from the front is expressly authorized or required				
22		by this chapter.				
23	3.	Flashing lights are prohibited except on an authorized:				
24			<u>authorized</u> emergency vehicle , schoolbus, snow-removal equipment;			
25			<u>schoolbus;</u>			
26			<u>iow-removal equipment;</u>			
27			vehicle owned by a funeral home, which may display a flashing purple light only			
28			<u>nile used for the purpose of escorting a funeral procession;</u> or on any			
29			y vehicle as a means of indicating a right or left turn, or the presence of a			
30			hicular traffic hazard requiring unusual care in approaching, overtaking, or			
31		pa	ssing.
