- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-05 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an apprenticeship grant program; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 34-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Apprenticeship grant program.

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>The labor commissioner shall administer an apprenticeship grant program to provide</u>
- 8 grants to eligible individuals enrolled in qualifying registered apprenticeship programs.
 9 within this state.
- 10 <u>2.</u> <u>The labor commissioner, in collaboration with the United States department of labor</u>
 and the state board for career and technical education shall:
- 12a.Establish eligibility guidelines for the program, including requiring full-time13enrollment, program progress, and a minimum grade point average or its14equivalent; and
- Award an eligible individual up to three thousand dollars within a three-year
 period while enrolled in an eligible program.

17 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND HUMAN RIGHTS -

18 **APPRENTICESHIP GRANT PROGRAM.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the

19 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,100,000, or so

- 20 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of labor and human rights for the
- 21 purpose of administering an apprenticeship grant program, for the biennium beginning July 1,
- 22 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.
