- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 15-10-38.1 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to eligibility for the skilled workforce student loan repayment
- 3 program; and to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 15-10-38.2 of the North Dakota

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 15-10-38.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
created and enacted as follows:

The requirement under subdivision c of subsection 4 is met if an individual is enrolled in or has completed a master of science degree in nursing while teaching four clinical credits per year and resides and works in this state in an occupation requiring the degree.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 15-10-38.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 4. The state board of higher education and the workforce development council shall compile a list of qualifying educational programs annually. A qualifying educational program is:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>Is</u> a program resulting in attainment of an associate's degree or lower credential program that may be completed within four semesters, six quarters, or the final two years of a baccalaureate program. A qualifying educational program alsomust
