- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a partial property tax exemption for residential property used for
- 3 in-home care services for a qualifying individual; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 created and enacted as follows:

- 7 Fifty percent of the taxable valuation of residential property used by a property owner
- 8 for in-home care of a qualifying individual. To claim an exemption under this
- 9 <u>subsection, the property owner claiming the exemption shall provide to the assessor,</u>
- 10 <u>on a form prescribed by the tax commissioner, the necessary information to</u>
- 11 <u>demonstrate eligibility. For purposes of the exemption:</u>
- a. "Direct relative" means a spouse, parent, grandparent, uncle, aunt, child, sibling,
 niece, or nephew, whether by blood, adoption, or marriage.
- 14 <u>b.</u> <u>"Qualifying individual" means the property owner's direct relative who is</u>
- 15 physically or mentally incapable of caring for themselves due to incapacity,
- 16 advancing age, physical or mental illness, or disability, and who lives in the
- 17 residential property with the property owner for more than fifty percent of the
 18 taxable year.
- 19 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
- 20 December 31, 2024.
