- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 19 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the creation of a safe food donation program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

5 enacted as follows:

6 Safe food donation program - Program participation requirements.

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>The department shall promote a safe food donation program.</u>
- 8 <u>2.</u> <u>To donate food under the program, an entity must be licensed under section 23-09-16.</u>
- 9 <u>3.</u> <u>A charitable organization is not required to have a commercial kitchen or to be certified</u>
 10 <u>by the department to receive food.</u>
- 11 <u>4.</u> <u>A charitable organization shall comply with food handling standards set by a local</u>
- 12 <u>public health unit.</u>
- 13 <u>5.</u> <u>A local public health unit shall:</u>
- 14 <u>a.</u> Inspect licensed entities participating in the program;
- 15b.Verify certification of an individual handling food on behalf of a charitable16organization; and
- 17 <u>c.</u> <u>Establish safety guidelines and regulate the program.</u>
- 18 **Protection and liability.**
- 19 <u>1.</u> <u>A donor operating under this chapter is protected under subsection 2 of section</u>
- 20 <u>32-03.1-02.2, provided the donor is in compliance with established safety guidelines.</u>
- 21 2. <u>A charitable organization receiving food shall comply with safety guidelines</u>
- 22 <u>established by a local public health unit to protect a recipient's health.</u>
- 23 Implementation Oversight Funding.
- 24 <u>1.</u> <u>The department shall establish:</u>

1		a. Inspection procedures; and
2		b. Educational resources to inform participating entities about safe food donation
3		practices.
4	<u>2.</u>	The department may establish grant and partnership opportunities to support
5		participating entities and encourage broad adoption of the safe food donation
6		program.
