- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to paid family caregiver services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Family caregiver services.
- The department shall submit an amendment to all current Medicaid 1915(c) waivers
 and those to be developed to provide payment for family caregiver services. The
 payment must be made to a legally responsible individual who provides care to an
 eligible individual participating in the Medicaid 1915(c) waiver program, excluding the
- 11 <u>aged and disabled waiver.</u>
- 12 <u>2. When a paid family caregiver service option is available through a Medicaid-approved</u>
- home and community-based services waiver, the department shall use an assessment
- 14 <u>to determine the level of care authorized which must consider the unique needs and</u>
- circumstances of all applicants including age, activities of daily living, medical needs,
- and social emotional needs. The assessment must be evidence-based.
- developmentally accurate, and include a family narrative.
- 18 3. A payment under this section to a legally responsible individual must be
- 19 <u>commensurate with the current self-directed direct support professional hourly wage. A</u>
- 20 <u>legally responsible individual may not be paid for more than 40 hours per week.</u>
- 21 <u>4.</u> The cross-disability advisory council shall participate with and advise the department
- 22 regarding the planning, design, and ongoing administration of the paid family caregiver
- service option on the Medicaid 1915(c) waiver. The council shall provide input into the

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- 1 <u>development of the assessment method used to determine the level of care authorized</u>
- 2 <u>for an individual.</u>
