- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of a legislative committee task force on government
- 3 efficiency; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - Legislative committeetask force on government efficiency Members Duties -
  - Report to the legislative management.
    - The legislative management, during each biennium, shall appoint create a legislative committee task force on government efficiency.
    - Each member of the task force shall serve two-year terms. The membership of the committee must consist of at least one member from each standing committee of the house of representatives and the senate, who served during the most recently completed regular session of the legislative assembly. The legislative management shall designate the chairman and appoint all members of the committee consistent with this subsectiontask force consists of:
- a. The chief information officer;

- c. The chief operating officer for the office of the governor;
- d. One elected statewide officer, appointed by the governor;

1	the legislative assembly is entitled to receive per diem compensation at the rate	
2	provided under section 54-35-10 for each day performing official duties of the task	
3	force. The legislative council shall pay the per diem compensation and reimbursement	
4	for travel and expenses as provided by law for any member of the task force who is a	
5	member of the legislative assembly.	
6	6. The legislative council shall provide staffing and administrative services for the task	
7	force through July 31, 2031.	
8	SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 2031, and after that	
9	date is ineffective.	
10	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
