- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the review of legislative measures by the Indian affairs commission
- 3 and tribal consultation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Review of legislative measures - Tribal consultation.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> Each legislative session, the director of the Indian affairs commission shall review
- 9 <u>each measure introduced to the legislative assembly and determine if the measure</u>
- 10 pertains to matters with tribal implications.
- 12 <u>2.</u> If the director determines a bill pertains to matters with tribal implications, the director
- 12 shall consult with the tribal chairpersons of each tribe before the standing committee
 13 hearing on the measure.
- 14 <u>3.</u> For purposes of this section:
- 15a."Consult" means the direct and interactive involvement of the North Dakota tribal16governments in the development of policy on matters with tribal implications,17which includes a proactive, affirmative process of identifying and seeking input
- 18 <u>from appropriate tribal governments and considering the tribal governments' input</u>
 19 as a necessary and integral part of the decisionmaking process.
- 20b."Matters with tribal implications" means a legislative measure that has a21substantial direct effect on one or more tribal nations within the geographical
- 22 boundaries of the state or on the distribution of power and responsibilities
- 23 <u>between the state and tribal governments.</u>
